Case Study -Westerham Solar Community

West Kent Housing Association is a sustainable energy champion and a powerful example for other social housing providers

West Kent Housing Association planned to build six new properties at the heart of the community in Westerham, Kent. With the help of the renewables team at Kent Energy Centre (KEC), the local branch of Creative Environmental Networks, the housing association have installed a Nuaire

SunWarm Solar Thermal and Whole House Ventilation System into each property. Through the installation of renewable energy systems, the Housing Association is demonstrating its committment to the preservation of the environment and is setting an excellent example to social housing providers nationwide.

It didn't cost the earth...

The KEC renewables team were able to secure 50% funding from Clear Skies Community Renewable Energy Grants, a DTI funding stream.

A bright beginning...and there's more to come

The Solar Thermal and Whole House Ventilation Systems will save each household 4300 kWh of energy a year. This means the project directly enables around 26,000 kWh of energy savings, reducing fuel bills by £500 each year.

It is estimated that use of the project will result in ${\rm CO_2}$ emissions savings of 4.9 tonnes each year.
